JUDGMENT/ORDER

This is an Compliant filed under sub-section (1) of Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005. Brief fact of the case is that the complainant Shri Dongru Tania on 18.01.2023 filed an RTI application under Form-A submitted before the PIO-Cum-EE, Department UD & Housing Division, Ziro, Lower Subansiri District, Arunachal Pradesh, whereby, seeking various information, as quoted in Form-A submitted application. The applicant, being not satisfied with the information received from the PIO, filed the First Appeal before the First Appellate Authority, the applicant again having not received the required information from the FAA, the aggrieved appellant filed Complaint to the Arunachal Pradesh Information Commission on 04.04.2023 and the Registry of the Commission (APIC), having receipt of the Complaint, registered it as **APIC No. 292/2023** and processed the same for its hearing and disposal.

Accordingly, matter came up for hearing before the Commission for 5 (five) consecutive times on 15.05.2023, 05.06.2023, 24.07.2023, 16.10.2023 & 04.10.2023 due to the PIO remained absent during the hearing. In this final hearing of the Complaint on 4th day of December,2023. The PIO is present during the hearing but the Complainant found absent however, he detailed his representative namely Tadar Tapak.

The PIO intimated to the Commission that he has furnished all the information to the Complainant as sought by the Complainant in his Form A application and he has also deposited the penalty imposed against him to the *head account no. '0070'* and Challan submitted to the office of the Commission, Itanagar, A.P. And he also paid the compensation of Rs.5000/- (five thousand) only to the Complainant as directed by the Commission in the last hearing dated on 16.10.2023

The Commission after going through the available records and documents and also hearing the statements of both the parties and other available evidences, the Commission has taken necessary action on the complaint. And the Commission also appraised the matter to the representative of the Complainant.

On this, the Representative of the complainant, after understanding the matter and satisfied the judgment of the Commission and he requested to dispose of and close the complaint.

In such viewing the fact and circumstances, and hearing from both the parties, I have a reason for believing of the fact that the representative of the complainant has fully Satisfied with the judgment of the Commission. Thus, I find this complaint fit to be disposed of as infructuous to continue the hearing.

And, accordingly, the complaint is disposed of as infructuous and closed once for all.
