JUDGMENT

This is an appeal filed under sub-section (3) of Section 19 of the RTI 2005. Brief fact of the case is that the Appellant Miss Barnali Bora on **25/04/2025** filed an RTI application in Form-'A' before the PIO-cum-Director of Audit & Pension, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh, Mini Secretariate, Naharlagun, Papumpare District. Whereby seeking various information as quoted in her Form 'A' application. The Appellant being not receiving the information from the PIO, filed the First Appeal before the First Appellate Authority (FAA) on **04/06/2025**. The Appellant again having not received the required information from the FAA, filed the Second Appeal before the Arunachal Pradesh Information Commission on **28/08/2025** and the Registry of the Commission (APIC) having receipt of the Appeal registered it as **APIC-No. 92/A/2026** (Appeal) and processed the same for its hearing and disposal.

Accordingly, matter came up for hearing before the Commission on **21.05.2026** and on **30.07.2026** wherein the Appellant found absent during the two hearings before the Commission.

In the second hearing, the PIO-cum-Director of Audit & Pension, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh, Mini Secretariate, Naharlagun, Papumpare District, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh is represented by Shri Kalak Tagi, Joint Director-cum-APIO during the hearing before the Commission.

Heard the representative of the PIO;

The representative of the PIO stated that the information(s) as applied by the Appellant have been provided to her on 23.04.2026, a copy of which has been provided to the State Information Commissioner hearing this appeal.

After hearing the representative of the PIO and going through the information(s) as provided by the PIO to the Appellant, the Commission hereby observes;

- 1) The information(s) as applied by the Appellant have been provided by the PIO to the Appellant.
- 2) The Appellant is absent consecutively for the 2nd time despite notified for the hearings to her at her official address as provided in her Form-A, two times i.e on 13.03.2026 & 21.05.2026.
- 3) The records produced by the PIO to the effect that the information(s) have been provided to the Appellant is taken into consideration by the Commission and the continuous absence of the Appellant in the hearing is seriously viewed by the Commission.

Under the above observations and following procedural law the Commission hereby dispose of this appeal ex-parte. And therefore, this appeal is disposed of and closed once for all with no liberty given to the Appellant to file fresh application for the same information from the same PIO.

In view of the above facts and circumstances the Commission dispose this Appeal ex-parte. And, accordingly, this Appeal stands disposed of and closed once for all.
