ORDER/SUMMON

This is an appeal under Section 19(3) of RTI Act, 2005 received from Shri Kimin Ingo for non-furnishing 20(twenty) point information on the c/o link road from Lombung to Puying under Rumgong Circle, Siang District by the PIO, o/o the EE (PWD) Rumgong Division, Siang District (A.P) as sought for by him under section 6(1) (Form-A) of RTI Act, 2005 vide his application dated 18.03.2025.

This appeal was, accordingly, listed for 2(two) times on 25.02.2026 and 25.03.26. On 25.02.26 neither party appeared but the appellant, vide letter dt.27.02.226, informed that he could not attend the hearing due to sudden death of his grandmother on 24.02.26. The hearing was, hence adjourned to 25.03.2026 wherein the PIO, Er. Shri Johney Darang, EE appeared through VC while the appellant was represented by Advocate Shri Dope Ori in person.

The PIO then submitted that the requested documents/information, except the Sl.No.18 (UC) and Sl.No.19(monthly monitoring report) are ready for furnishing to the appellant. The Ld. Counsel for the appellant submitted that the UC and the Monitoring Report of the project are the most important documents/information and that if these are not available, an affidavit to that effect should be furnished.

This Commission, endorsing the submission of the Ld. Counsel *that it is the requirement of law {section -7(8)(i) of the RTI Act} that when an information is denied to the applicant, the reason thereof has to be communicated to the applicant to his satisfaction and that as mandated by section-18(3)(c) and under rule- 5(vi) of the AP Information Commission (Appeal Procedure) Rules, 2005, the submission/reply of the PIO has to be declared/supported by way of an affidavit*, the PIO was directed to furnish the requested documents with suitable replies to those information/documents which are not available in his office through speed post to the appellant within 2(two) weeks from the date of receipt of the order dt.25.03.2026 and report compliance thereof by 08.04.2026. This appeal was, thus, disposed of and closed in above terms.

The appellant, Shri Kimin Ingo, vide his letter dt.06.04.26, as reproduced below, however, complained that the PIO failed to furnish the documents inspite of this Commission's direction contained in order dt.25.03.2026.

"Sir,

With due respect and humble submission, I would like to solicit your good office that, on 25th day of March '2026 the matter had been fixed for hearing in your court with the PIO cum Executive Engineer, PWD, Rungong, Siang Dist. A.P. As per judgment dated 25th March, 2026, the PIO had been directed to furnish the documents within two weeks from the date of the judgment. And the appellant had also directed to inform this court on 8th day of April'2026. As I am informing that since the date of judgment to till date, the concerned PIO had fails to furnish the documents and fails to comply the court direction.

Therefore, you are highly solicited to continue the hearing and requested to fix the next date of hearing as per the convenient of the court as soon as possible' I shall be highly obliged to you and your altruistic gesticulation.

As already directed, the PIO shall furnish the left out information/documents or the Affidavit to the appellant and report compliance thereof on 13.05.2026 the next date of hearing failing which this Commissions shall be constrained to invoke the provisions of section 20 of the RTI Act, 2005 against the PIO.
