ORDER/SUMMONS

This is an appeal under Section 19(3) of RTI Act, 2005 received from Shri Tanya Ronya and Shri Penter Ronya for non-furnishing of below mentioned information by the PIO, o/o the E.E (PWD), Yomcha Division, West Siang District (A.P) as sought for by them under section 6(1) (Form-A) of RTI Act, 2005 vide their application dated 25.06.2025:

This appeal is heard for the 3rd time today on 15.07.2026 the 1st and 2nd times being on 08.05.2026 and 10th June, 2026 respectively.

On 08.05.2026 this Commission, upon hearing the appellant in person, and on perusal of the points as contained in the Annexure-A to the RTI application on which the information/documents have been sought, which were found not covered by any of the exemption clauses of section 8(1) of the RTI Act, 2005, directed the PIO to furnish the same as requested by the appellants within 1(one) month of the receipt of order dt.08.05.26 and report the compliance thereof to this Commission on 10.06.2026. It was, however, made clear in the order that if the o/o the PIO does not hold any of the requested information/documents, he shall declare so on an affidavit as required under section-18(3)(c) of the RTI Act, 2005 and under rule- 5(vi) of the AP Information Commission (Appeal Procedure) Rules, 2005.

On 10.06.26, the appellant appeared through V C, while Er. Shri Marge Bagra, the EE-cum-PIO appeared in person who submitted that he joined the present Division recently and taken the charge only on 02.06.26 and therefore, not well aware of the appeal in question and therefore, pleaded for sufficient time to arrange the requested information/documents.

This Commission considered the request of the PIO and granted him 1(one) month time to collate and furnish the requested information to the appellant and report compliance thereof on 10th July, 2026 and adjourned the hearing to today on 15.07.2026.

Today on 15.07.2026, one of the appellants, namely, Shri T. Ronya is present in person while the PIO, Er. Shri Marghe Bagra, EE appeared through VC.

Heard the parties.

The PIO submitted that out of the 18 (eighteen) queries against each of the 11 (eleven) various schemes, the replies/information to queries Nos. 1, 9, 11 and 18 are available but the information/documents in respect of 13 queries could not be traced out.

The appellant pleaded that if the replies/documents against any of the queries is not available in the o/o the PIO, then the PIO be directed to furnish the replies on an affidavit.

This Commission, after hearing the parties, reminded the PIO of the requirement of the law under section-7(8)(i) of the RTI Act, 2005 that when an information is denied to the applicant, the reason thereof has to be communicated to the applicant to his/her satisfaction. And in terms of section-18(3)(c) r/w rule- 5(vi) of the A.P Information Commission (Appeal Procedure) Rules, 2005, the submission/reply of the PIO has to be declared on an affidavit.

The PIO shall comply with the above direction within 2(two) weeks from the date of receipt of this order and report the compliance thereof on 31.07.2026, the next date of hearing. The appellant is also directed to intimate the receipt of the information to this Commission within one week of the receipt of the same failing which this appeal shall stand closed.

NOW THEREFORE, you are hereby summoned to appear in person or online in the Hon'ble Court of Shri Sangyal Tsering Bappu, **SIC on 31.07.2026 (Friday) at 2 pm** to answer the claims, and you are directed to produce on that day all the documents upon which you intend to rely in support of your claims/defense.

Take notice that, in default of your appearance, on the day above- mentioned, the matter will be heard and determined in your absence.
