**An Appeal Case U/S 19(3) of RTI Act, 2005**

**ORDER/SUMMON**

This is an appeal under Section 19(3) of RTI Act, 2005 received from Shri Tamchi Gungte for non-furnishing of below mentioned information by the PIO, o/o the Executive Engineer (PHE & WS), Tezu Division, Lohit District (A.P) as sought for by him under section 6(1) (Form-A) of RTI Act, 2005 vide his application dated 20.09.2025.

**A) Particular of information:** C/o "total list of completed Works/ projects sponsored by State fund/ Central fund or both (such as SIDF/ BE/ RE/ RIDF/ SADA/ ADA/ MLALAD/ MPLAD/ SPA/ Article 275(1)/ PMJVK/ CRIF/ PMDeVine/ NEC/ NESIDS / Non-BADP, SASCI/ FMBAP/NRDWM/ SBM, Maintenance works etc), executed under the concern division" from the financial year 2016-17 to 2025-26.

**B) Details of information required:**

- 1) Furnish the certified copy of Total list of works/projects completed by the division under various scheme head mentioned above (state/central scheme or both as mentioned above) for each financial year from 2016-17 to 2025-26.
- 2) Furnish the certified copy of Sanction order/ Administrative Approval (AA) & Expenditure Sanction (ES) of each completed projects in respect of serial No. 1 mentioned above for each financial year from 2016-2017 to 2025-2026.
- 3) Furnish the certified copy of Technical Sanction (TS) of each completed projects in respect of serial no. 1 mentioned above for each financial year from 2016-17 to 2025-26.
- 4) Furnish the certified copy of Agreement made between the Contractor and Executing Agency, for each completed projects/works from the financial 2016-17 to 2025-26.
- 5) Furnish the certified copy of Work Order (with amount mentioned) issued to the contractor with respect to serial no. 1. (only for the work awarded in work order form) 2016-17 to 2025-26.
- 6) Furnish the Details of fund Surrendered to the Govt. Head Account, in respect of serial no. 1 of my form-A
- c) Remaining balance amount after A/A E/S and TS has been done. (Enclosed the proof of surrender such as Challan copy or whichever method has been used.)
- d) b) Remaining Balance amount after TS and Contract Agreement of the project/work. (Enclosed the proof of surrender such as Challan copy or whichever method has been used)

- 7) Furnish the Details of Expenditures of fund if been utilised, in respect of serial no. 1 of my Form-A:-
- c) Remaining balance amount after A/A E/S and TS has been completed. (Enclosed the proof of Expenditure.)
- d) Remaining Balance amount after TS and Contract Agreement/work order amount of the projects/works. (Enclosed the proof of expenditure)
- 8) Furnish the certified details of Officer (name & Designation) who authorized/approve the surrender process of fund in respect of serial no. 6 of the Form-A.
- 9) Furnish the certified details of Officer who authorized/approve the expenditures of fund in respect of serial no. 7 of Form-A.
- 10)Furnish the Rules followed by the Division Officers (under CPWD works manual/ any other etc.) that authorize the officers to make an expenditures of fund beyond the Contract agreement/Work Order amount in respect of the projects/works.
- 11)Furnish all the above documents with CTC & proper manner (i.e. in serial wise with properly Index and proper paging of each financial year).

This appeal is heard for the 3<sup>rd</sup> time today on 02.09.26, the first two times being on 27.05.2026 and 05.08.2026.

On 27.05.2026 wherein the PIO, Shri Nure Linggi, EE, was present through VC but the appellant was absent, this Commission, upon hearing the PIO that the appellant, despite his (PIO) advice to collect the information / documents, did not turn up to collect the documents and perusing the PIO's letter dt.27.11.2025 to the appellant and also taking into account the absence of the appellant in the hearing, had closed the appeal as not being interested by the appellant.

However on receipt of complaint from the appellant, vide letter dt.02.07.2026 that the PIO's statement was not completely true, this Commission, vide order dt. 06.07.26, recalled its order dt.27.05.2026 and listed the appeal on 05.08.2026 with direction to the PIO to furnish the requested documents to the appellant and report compliance thereof to this Commission on 05.08.26.

On 05.08.2026, the PIO was absent but the appellant was present who produced letter dt.14.07.2026 from the PIO advising him to collect the documents/information from the o/o the PIO.

This Commission, after hearing the appellant that he is planning to visit the o/o the PIO, at Tezu after the hearing on 05.08.26, directed him to collect the information/documents from the o/o the PIO and report the receipt thereof to this Commission mentioning the short coming, if any, on 2<sup>nd</sup> Sept, 2026.

#### **Hearing and interim decision:**

Today on 02.09.26, the appellant is present in person while the PIO, Er. Kalen Mibang appeared through VC.

The PIO submitted that since the appellant did not turn up for collection of the documents from his office as directed, the documents were dispatched to the appellant through speed post. The appellant acknowledging the receipt of the document, however, complained that the documents furnished by the PIO are not according to his RTI application.

The appellant, therefore, pleaded for penal action against the PIO for providing misleading information, thereby failing to comply with the provisions of RTI Act and also adequate compensation to him for the harassment he suffered due to inaction on the part of the PIO.

This Commission, upon hearing the parties and on perusal of the points on which the appellant had sought the information which are found not covered by any of the exemption clauses, directs the PIO, in the interim, to furnish the requested information to the appellant as per the queries in the RTI application within 3(three) weeks from the date of receipt of this order and report the compliance thereof on 25.09.2026, the next date of hearing failing which consequential penal action under section 20 of the RTI Act including payment of compensation to the appellant, shall be initiated against him.

Take notice that, in default of your appearance, on the day above- mentioned, the matter will be heard and determined in your absence.

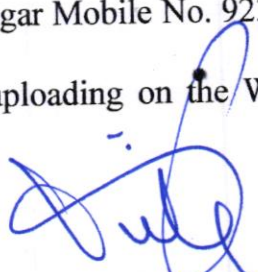
