**ARUNACHAL PRADESH INFORMATION COMMISSION**  
**ITANAGAR.**

**An Appeal Case U/S 19(3) of RTI Act, 2005**  
**Case No. APIC- 704/2025.**

**APPELLANT** : Shri Bamang Pacho, IG Park, Itanagar.  
**RESPONDENT** : The PIO, o/o the EE (PWD), Koloriang Division, Kurung  
Kumey District.

**ORDER**

This is an appeal under Section 19(3) of RTI Act, 2005 received from Shri Bamang Pacho for non-furnishing of 8(eight) point information each against 6(six) schemes by the PIO, o/o the EE (PWD), Sangram Division, KurungKumey District as sought for by him under section 6(1) (Form-A) of RTI Act, 2005 vide his application dated 04.06.2025.

This appeal was heard 3(three) times on 13.02.2026, 18.03.26 and 29.04.26.

On 13.02.26, this Commission, vide order dt.13.02.26, after hearing the representative of the PIO, Shri Bini Tare, i/c RTI Cell, who submitted that consequent upon bifurcation of Koloriang Division from the Sangram Division the handing and taking over of the charge of the Koloriang Division has been done on 14.10.2025 and that consequently for the pending RTI cases till 14.10.2025 in respect of the Koloriang Division, the EE (Koloriang Division) be summoned, directed *the PIOs of both the Sangram Division and Koloriang Division to appear in the next date on 18.03.26 to hear them and decide as to whose Division shall provide the requested information.*

On 18.03.26, Shri Bini Tare, representing the PIO, Sangram (PWD) Division was present in person who produced the copy PIO's letter dt.16/10/2026 regarding the handing and taking over of the charges between the EE, Sangram Division and EE, Koloriang Division along with the list of RTI applications including the application dt.04.06.2025 siezed in the instant appeal. The appellant was also present in person but the PIO, Koloriang (PWD) Division was absent.

The representative of the PIO, Sangram Division, reiterating earlier submission of the PIO that the in view of handing over of the RTI cases including the 6(six) schemes in his RTI application dt. 04.06.25 to the EE, Koloriang Division, pleaded that the PIO o/o EE (Koloriang Division) be summoned and heard henceforth.

In view of the factual position as evidenced by the POI's aforesaid letter this Commission decided to summon the PIO o/o EE, Koloriang Division and consequently, vide this Commission's order dt.18.03.26, the PIO o/o the EE, PWD, Koloriang Division, was directed to appear in the next hearing on 29<sup>th</sup> April 2026, along with the requested documents. But the PIO, Koloriang Division was again absent. The appellant was also absent without any intimation.

The appellant, vide his letter dt.08.05.2026, meanwhile, pleaded for listing the appeal again as he did not receive the requested information from the PIO.

In the mean time another appeal No APIC-703/2025 filed by the appellant against the same respondent PIO was listed and heard on 27.05.26 and after hearing the parties, this Commission passed the following order:

*“During the course of hearing the PIO was reminded of this Commission’s interim orders dt.21.01.2026 in 4(four) appeals namely, APIC-366/25, APIC-367/25, APIC-368/25 and API-369/25 and order dt.29.04.26 in APIC-704/25 which are pending final adjudication in this Commission against the instant respondent PIO and the PIO, Sangram PWD Division. The issues in those orders pertain to the question as to whose office, (whether that of PIO, Koloriang Division or that of the PIO, Sangram Division) will provide the information sought for by the appellant. The PIO, on pointed query, admitting fairly that the documents pertaining to the schemes falling under the jurisdiction of Koloriang have actually been transferred and handed over to the Koloriang PWD Division from the Sangram PWD Division on bifurcation of the Koloriang Division from the Sangram Division, confirmed that the PIO, o/o Koloriang Division shall furnish the requested documents / information, the records whereof are also currently under the custody of the CBI.*

*In view of the PIO’s confirmation as above, this Commission concludes that the information/documents as sought for by the appellant in the aforesaid 5(five) appeals shall be provided by the o/o the PIO, Koloriang PWD Division and consequently, the PIO, o/o Sangram PWD Division shall, henceforth be no longer responsible for furnishing the requested documents in respect of the schemes listed in the aforesaid 5(five) appeals. This Commission, thus, directs the PIO, Koloriang (PWD) Division to furnish the requested information / documents in all the 6(six) appeals, including the instant appeal, to the appellant as soon as the documents are received from the CBI.”*

Since the instant appeal No.APIC-704/2025 is also against the same respondent PIO, the said appeal has been clubbed with the other 4(four) appeals namely, APIC-366/25, APIC-367/25, APIC-368/25 and API-369/25 and directed the PIO furnish the requested information/documents as soon as those are received from the CBI. The copy of the common order dt.29.05.26 passed in the appeal No.APIC-366/2025 is attached herewith for records and reference.
