Information sought:

The appellant filed an RTI application dated 30.10.2025 seeking information regarding following schemes:

- 1) LO23-Rd. From Talli – Pija PMGSY Road to Neopum (Rs. 8658.54 lakhs).
- 2) LO24-Rd. From Pija PMGSY Road to Richik (Rs. 3230.84 lakhs).
- 3) LO21-Rd. From Pija to Habak (Rs. 2703.82 lakhs).
- 4) LO22-Rd. From Parsi Parlo PWD road Kopin to Hapuk (I) (Rs. 3923.89 lakhs).

Details of information required:

1. Furnish details of sanction order copy from Govt. of India under VVP (Part-II) for the year 2023-2024 of above-mentioned schemes.

2. Furnish details of sanction order copy from your district concerned department and state government against VVP (Part-II) for the year 2023-2024 of above-mentioned schemes.
 3. Furnish details project report of above-mentioned schemes.
 4. Furnish the copy of notification and NIT under VVP (Part-II) of above-mentioned schemes.
 5. Furnish the total number of firm/contractors participated in the said tender process and class of firm/contractor and type of tender.
 6. Furnish the copy of declaration of tender bids result and name of the successful bidder along with rate quoted by successful bidder and other non-responsive evolution.
 7. Furnish the name and designation of tender evolution committee and copy of approval letter issued by the competent authority.
 8. Furnish the copy of work order and acceptance letter for processed to work to the successful bidders/ firm/ contractors and comparative statement with department rate of all technical qualified firm, BOQ of qualified firms and agreement letter, process work order letter and mobilization release amount.
 9. Furnish the copy of Govt. guidelines under VVP (Part-II) order/notification and circular, if any for implementation of above-mentioned schemes.
 10. Furnish the duration and stipulated period of above said project.
 11. Furnish the technical sanction order copy of above said project.
 12. Furnish the technical bid and financial bid documents.
 13. Furnish the inspection report of each project starting to ending and monthly progress report.
 14. Furnish the bill copy and money receipt copy if released.
 15. Furnish the work executive EE/AE/Jes name of above-mentioned schemes.
 16. Furnis Geo-tag & photography copy of each project from starting to ending.
 17. Furnish the utilization certificate.
 18. Furnish the NOC copy of concern village i.e. HGB, GBs of each project.
 19. Furnish the agreement copy with land owner should be made judicial stamp paper with seal and signature of judicial magistrate of above-mentioned schemes.
 20. Furnish NOC from forest department, PHED & WS, WRD, Agri/Horti, PWD, Electrical etc for non-duplicacy of the project.
 21. Details if any furnished along with cheque counterfoil and payment made for land compensation to any person, if so, indicate the name of beneficiary.
 22. Furnish all the documents in CTC.
 23. Furnish the LOCC copy time to time released.
- Period for: VVP (pt-II) 2023-2024-2025.

Relevant facts emerged during hearing:

Previous Hearing:

First : 08.05.2026

Order of the 1st hearing- *"The Commission observed that this appeal was remanded to the FAA – Chief Engineer, RWD W/Z (PMGSY) on 11.2.2026 directing him to hear the first appeal and pass reasoned and speaking order on merit on or before 6.3.2026. But there is no record of FAA having heard the appeal and dispose of the case. He has failed to perform the statutory duty entrusted to him. The appellant vide his letter dated 26.3.2026 intimated that the FAA – Chief Engineer, RWD W/Z (PMGSY) has not conducted any hearing thereby neglected the*

direction of this commission and requested to take up hearing in the commission court. Today the representative of the PIO submits that the information has already been furnished to the appellant on 18.2.2026 and the appellant has received it from him. The appellant is directed to confirm to this commission of having received the information and its status within ten days from the date of issue this order."

The following were present.

Appellant

: Present. He states that he has already received the information but the information document does not conform to information sought in RTI application.

Respondent PIO

: Absent. Shri Romik Talo, JE attended without any authorisation letter from the PIO. He states that any additional information required within the purview of RTI application shall be furnished to the appellant.

On interjection the appellant could not specify the shortfall in the information already received by him. He sought one-week time to file a written submission to the PIO specifying the shortfall in the information.

Decision:

The commission after adverting to the facts and circumstances of the case, perusal of the records and hearing the parties, observes that the appellant has submitted a letter dated 23.05.2026 to this commission intimating that he has not received any information from the PIO. In today's hearing the appellant states that he has received the information afterwards from the PIO but the information furnished is not satisfactory and sought one week's time to file a written submission to the PIO specifying the shortfall in the information. The PIO – Executive Engineer, RWD, Tali Division remained absent in the two consecutive hearing in this commission court thereby he has violated the statutory duty of a public authority under the provision of RTI Act, 2005.

The appellant is directed to file a written submission to the PIO specifying the shortfall in information already received by him within one week from the date of issue of this order and obtain acknowledgement, and submit a copy of it to this commission. The PIO shall furnish any additional information to the appellant within two weeks upon receipt of such written submission from the appellant under intimation to this commission. The PIO shall attend the next hearing personally or through properly authorised representative / legal counsel.

Next date of hearing shall be fixed on receipt of compliance report of this order from the appellant and PIO. In case no compliance report is received at commission from the PIO and appellant within stipulated time, this appeal case shall stand closed.

Order pronounced in the Open Court of this Commission today this 24th day of July' 2026. Each copy of the Judgement / Order be furnished to the parties.
