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Information sought:

The appellant filed an RTI application dated 11.11.2024 seeking following information regarding list of project/work sanctioned under Article 275 (1) of the constitution of India, by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs Govt. of India" during the financial year 2017-19 during the financial year 2024-25.

The total list of work / Projects are as follows: -

- 1. Construction of 100 bedded boy's hostel (dormitory type) with boundary wall for Govt. Hr. Sec. School Namsai in Namsai block of Namsai district. A.P. (2016-17)
- 2. Construction of double storey RCC hostel building with brick walling & CGI roofing for 100 girl's Govt. Hr. Sec. School Namsai in Namsai block of Namsai district. A.P. (2018-19)
- 3. Construction of double storey RCC school building at Govt. Secondary School Piyong (Nigroo) in Namsai block of Namsai district. A.P. (2018-19)
- 4. Construction of double storey RCC hostel building with brick walling & CGI roofing for 100 girl's Govt. Hr. Sec. School Namsai in Namsai block of Namsai district. A.P. (2018-19)

- 1. Construction of 60 Boarders girls hostel at Govt. Hr. Sec. School at Tirbin West Siang District, West Siang Dist. A.P. (2018-19)
- 2. Construction and Extension of Laboratory Female and Male ward and Maternity ward at PHC, Tirbin in West Siang District. (2017-18)
- 3. Construction of 60 Boarders Girls Hostel with 8 nos. additional class room at Govt. Upper Primary School Deke in West Siang District. (2017-18)
- 4. Construction of Additional hostel building for 40 boarders for Govt. H.S School Kamba West Siang Dist.

Particulars of sought information are given below: -

- 1. Furnish the certified Sanction Order Copy.
- 2. Furnish the certified PRC (Permanent Residence Certificate) submitted by tender Participant issued by the Competent Authority regarding domicile status with the districts as per Rule 4(ii)(b) of the Arunachal Pradesh District Based Entrepreneurs and Professionals (Incentive, Development and Promotion) rules, 2015 & 2020.
- 3. Furnish the certified copy of Proof (such as Voter ID and PRC) that the tender winning firm Domicile status within the Territorial jurisdiction of that Constituency Assembly as per District Based Entrepreneur and Professionals (Incentive, Development and Promotion) rules, 2015 & 2020.
- 4. Furnish the certified LOC Copy with respect to the subject mentioned above.
- 5. Furnish the certified copy of Technical Sanction done by the concerned Authority for the projects as per financial rules.

- 6. Furnish the certified copy of Utilization Certificate.
- 7. Furnish the certified copy of Notice Inviting Tender (NIT) with respect to the subject mentioned above.
- 8. Furnish the certified Progress Report of the projects in Physical and Financial section till date.
- 9. Furnish the certified copy of Completion certificate of the project.
- 10. Furnish the certified copy of Newspaper in which NIT was published (At least 3 newspaper name (one National & 2 Local)) along with date of publication of Newspaper, as per Government approved Order.
- 11. Furnish the certified Design and Scope of Work in the projects.
- 12. Furnish the certified copy of Work Specification of the projects.
- 13. Furnish the certified copy of documents submitted by tender participant for Technical Bid.
- 14. Furnish the Name of Firms who won the Tender work with respect to the subject mentioned above.
- 15. Furnish the Name of Officers and their Designation at the Time of monitoring the work.
- 16. Furnish the certified copy of Contractor Registration, of the tender participant and tender winning Firm.
- 17. Furnish the certified copy of Contractor Enlistment Update reports (Civil/Composite Category as per the nature of work), of tender participant and winning Firm.
- 18. Furnish the certified copy of EMD and Security money deposited by all the tender participant.
- 19. Furnish the certified Integrity Pact submitted by the tender participant.
- 20. Furnish the certified Affidavit copy Sworn before a Competent Magistrate to the effect that he/she (tender participant), does not have 2 (Two) or more incomplete ongoing commitment (projects/contract to execute) at the time of bidding by the tender participant and winning firm. (as per rule SPWD/W-66/2012 Dtd. 01-08-2018 as per District Based Entrepreneurship Act, 2015 & 2020).
- 21. Furnish the certified documents submitted by tender participant and winning firm, i.e. copy of completed Three similar work each of value not less than 40% of the estimate cost or Completed Two Similar work each of value not less than 60% of the estimated cost or Completed One similar work of value not less than 80% of the estimated cost along with the Completion Certificate issued by the Engineer in Charge duly Countersigned by the Concerned Superintending Engineer and Chief

Engineer, in the last 5 years ending last day of the month previous to the one in which the tenders are invited.

- 22. Furnish the certified reasons & provision to adopt TURNKEY/EPC Basis to execute this project.
- 23. Furnish the certified copy of Acceptance letter for Tender work by the Executing Agency to the tender Winning Firm.
- 24. Furnish the certified copy of Work Order given to the Contractor by the Executing Department.
- 25. Furnish the Agreement Copy made between the Contractor and the Executive Agency for the projects mentioned above.
- 26. Furnish the certified copy of all Photograph of work items (Glossy paper) before starting of work and Photograph (Glossy Paper) after completion of work.
- 27. Furnish the Geo Coordinate information for the work mentioned above.
- 28. Furnish the certified Payment Details (Cheque no., voucher, PFMS etc. (Which ever method is used of payments)) of the project till date.
- 29. Furnish the certified Solvency certificate certified by the Bankers, submitted by all the tender participant.
- 30. Furnish the certified Credit facility from Bankers (10% of the tender value) submitted by the tender participants.
- 31. Furnish the certified Affidavit to invest cash up to (25% of tender value) submitted by the tender participant.

Decision:

In the absence of both the PIO and appellant, the case is not heard.

The Commission after adverting to the facts and circumstances of the case and perusal of the records observes that the first appellate authority has issued a hearing notice to the PIO and appellant on 17.1.2025 for hearing on 30.1.2025 but there is no record of any judgement order.

The Commission has directed the FAA to disposed of the first appeal filed to him by following statutory procedure laid down in the Arunachal Pradesh Right to

Information (Appeal Procedure) Rules, 2005. So, this appeal case is decided and determined in the absence of PIO and appellant as made known to them in the hearing notice.

As laid down at para-38 of the Guidelines for the FAA issued by the GoI and the State Govt. OM No. AR-111/2008 Dated 21st August, 2008, adjudication on the appeals under RTI Act is a quasi-judicial function. It is, therefore, necessary that the Appellate Authority should see to it that the justice is not only done but it should also appear to have been done. In order to do so, the order passed by the appellate authority should be a speaking order giving justification for the decision arrived at.

Therefore, the instant appeal case is remanded to First Appellate Authority. Therefore, the FAA - Chief Engineer (W/Z), RWD, Govt. of AP., following the principle of natural justice, shall conduct hearing giving fair and equal opportunity to both the appellant and the PIO and thereafter pass reasoned and speaking order on merit within two weeks from the date of receipt of this order i.e. on or before 21st August 2025.

The appellant is at liberty to file 2nd appeal afresh if not satisfied with the information furnished to him by PIO based on the judgement order passed by the FAA. Fee for such 2nd appeal, if done, shall be exempted.
